When possible, it is highly recommended that Mount St. Helens open an evening. It is dramatic, fast-paced, and full of photos. Perhaps most importantly, it brushes up against the notion that the earth may not be billions of years old – in a very evidence-based, non-threatening manner. The Titanic did not turn on dime; most non-Christians and many Christians have been trained their whole lives to think in terms of billions of years. For such people, to even *consider* an alternative way of thinking is very difficult inside the space of a single workshop. Mount St. Helens uses just plain science to "turn the rudder." It gives them "scientific permission" to think in a new way, and helps them get used to (what is, for many) a *totally new* idea…a way of thinking that may seem crazy to some, and scary to others – because the implications can be life-changing.

Mount St. Helens builds a 'foundation.' The other workshops build on this foundation. Most audiences will benefit by beginning with Mount St. Helens provides, but not all need it. A Christian audience that is already familiar with the basics of young-earth creationism may benefit more from a different workshop in the first time slot.

Several different workshops can fill the second time slot. The age of the earth is the presenter's expertise – and it is highly recommended. It contains a lot of 'necessary basics' – information that few people know, but from which all can benefit. The workshop begins by establishing, without relying on the Bible, that nothing in science *demands* billions of years. It then displays five reasons, supported by specific verses, why the Bible prohibits billions of years.

Depending upon the particular audience and their preferences, several other workshops are available. Please see the summary of the various workshops.
